CALL FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

INSURANCE (MOTOR VEHICLE THIRD PARTY RISKS) ACT, CAP. 405, LAWS OF KENYA

The Insurance Regulatory Authority is a statutory government agency established under the Insurance Act (Amendment) 2006, CAP 487 of the Laws of Kenya to regulate, supervise and to promote the development of insurance industry in Kenya.

The Authority hereby notifies members of public and Insurance Industry Stakeholders, of its intention to amend Rule 3 of the Insurance (Motor Vehicle Third Party Risks) (Certificate of Insurance) Rules, 1999, under Cap. 405, Laws of Kenya. The Authority's intention to initiate this amendment is with a view that all motor cycles (including *boda bodas*) and three wheeled vehicles (including *tuk-tuks*), used in the business of transporting fare-paying passengers will have compulsory third-party insurance.

Pursuant to Article 10 of the Constitution and Section 5(1) of the Statutory Instruments Act, the public is hereby invited to submit Memoranda and/or Representations on the proposed amendments on or before 10th December 2021.
